Please find attached to this newsletter copies of the Phase Newsletters for your child. The newsletters are to introduce you to your Phase Leaders and support staff and covers every day things you will need to know for your child in their new year group.

## **Harvest Parcels**

As part of our Harvest celebrations we are asking if families could possible donate a parcel box that can be delivered to an older family member or elder member of the local community. The boxes normally contain dried and tinned grocery goods (no fruit, vegetables or other perishable goods please). Please could all boxes be brought in by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October in readiness for our Harvest assembly that day. If you would like your parcel to go to a particular person, please add their name and address to the box. Children are welcome to include letters, pictures and photos inside the box but please try to include both names of the child as it makes it easier for thank you notices to be delivered to the correct children.



## **Nut Ban**

Due to severe nut allergies within school, please note that we are now a nut free school. This means that neither staff or children are allowed to bring nuts or items with nuts into school. Please do not include whole nuts or items containing nuts in your child's lunchbox. For children in Years 3-6, please ensure you do not send any sort of nuts in as a mid-morning snack, this includes cereal bars containing nuts.



## **Library Reading Challenge**

If any children have a certificate for taking part in the library Reading Challenge over the summer, please can these be brought into school by next Friday morning so that they can be shown in next Friday mornings' Celebration Assembly.

## **Reception Tour Dates**

We have a number of dates arranged for prospective parents to view our school. ## **Nursery Registrations**

We still have spaces available in our nursery for September 2017 for children who were born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2014. Please bring your child's birth certificate to the main school office to register.

## School Performances

We have a tradition at Loatlands of putting on a range of plays and performances for the children to take part in. As a school with growing numbers we wish to maintain this wish so will be making some changes this year to accommodate all children.

- Phase 2 children (Years 2/3) will be taking part in a Harvest performance at the end of term which will be over three performances Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2.15pm and Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2.15pm and 6pm. Further details about arrangements will be released in due course.
- Children in Phase 1 (Years R/1) will be taking part in a tradition nativity together whilst Phase 2 and 3 will be holding traditional choral concerts.
- Children in Phase 3 (Years 4/5) will be taking part in an Easter performance whilst Year 6 will be showcasing talents in their end of year leavers play.

We hope to be able to offer as many tickets as we can to family members but will ensure the children do not become too tired, audience members have a clear view and we are within our fire safety requirements for the hall.

## Holidays during School Time

Parents are encouraged not to take their children out of school during term time. However, if you do decide to take your child out of school, please avoid the following dates as this is when children undertake National assessments and these cannot be retaken:

Year 6 SATS – week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> May 2018

Year 2 SATS – whole of May 2018

Year 1 Phonics Screening – week commencing 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018

If the holiday request is for 5 or more days continuous leave and is not authorised it will automatically be referred to the education entitlement Service for a Fixed Penalty Notice to be issued. The initial fixed penalty notice is currently £60 per parent per child i.e. a 2-parent family with 2 children would be fined £240, which needs to be paid to the Local Authority within 21 days. If payment is received between 21-28 days of issue the fine rises to £120 per parent per child i.e. £480 for a 2-parent and 2-child family. If payment is not received within 28 days of issue you may be prosecuted for the offence of irregular attendance and could be subject to a fine of up to £1,000 on conviction. **Please note that the school does not receive any of this money.**

## Secondary School Applications

Parents of children in Year 6 need to consider their application for secondary school. The easiest way to apply is online at [www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions) The deadline for applying for a second school place is **5pm on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017.**
