New Playground Markings

This year the Central Government has doubled the grant given to schools for their Physical Education programme. As a school we have used some of this grant money to update our playground facilities to encourage more activity during break and lunchtimes. The aerial photos below show the infant playground now has hopscotch, 'mirror me' and other activities, as well as a two-lane running track which runs around the infant playground, all the way up the slope onto the junior playground and all around the junior playground as well. Thank you to all of the parents and children who attended our maths workshop, it was great to see the children so enthusiastic about joining in with the number games and songs.


