



### Penny Sweets

<b>Penny Sweets</b>	<b>Bigger Treats</b>	
<p><b>Reading</b> You can read:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book</li><li>- Other Fiction books, short stories, poetry collections</li><li>- magazines, comics, newspapers</li><li>- Non-fiction books, information texts, recipe books</li></ul> <p><i>Make sure that an adult signs your Reading Record every time you read so that you can claim your House Points. We will check Reading Records every <b>Monday</b>.</i></p>	<p><b>Wonderful Writing</b> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Design and write a postcard about a trip to the seaside. Try to use lots of interesting adjectives. E.g. I went in the <i>deep blue</i> sea and had a <i>tasty</i> ice cream. It was <i>hot</i> and <i>sunny</i> at the beach.</li><li>2) What do you need to take with you for a seaside holiday? Write a list using numbers or bullet points.</li></ol>	
<p><b>Practise your 2 times tables.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- counting in 2's forwards and backwards.</li><li>- 2 times table games on the internet.</li><li>- Listen to 2 times table songs.</li><li>- Roll a dice and multiply the numbers</li></ul>	<p><b>Magnificent maths</b> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Place Value – tens and ones, choose a 2-digit number and draw a picture to represent using tens and ones.</li><li>2) Make a snap game for days of the week, months of the year or addition to 10 then 20. E.g. 3+3 and 5+1 both make 6 = snap!</li></ol>	
<p><b>Learn spellings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Look, say, cover, write, check</li><li>- Ask someone to test you</li><li>- Is there a spelling rule that helps?</li><li>- Identify the tricky part &amp; a way to remember it</li></ul> <p><i>Don't forget spelling tests are every <b>Friday</b>. New spellings are given out on a <b>Friday</b>.</i></p>	<p><b>Super Science</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Make a list or draw some animals or minibeasts. Challenge - can you label their body parts and draw their habitats/homes?</li></ol>	
<p><b>Maths Games</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Use your login for Purple Mash</li><li>- Play maths games on <a href="http://www.ictgames.com">www.ictgames.com</a> and <a href="http://www.topmarks.co.uk">www.topmarks.co.uk</a>.</li></ul>	<p><b>Poster Perfect</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Draw a map showing the route from your house to school. Look out for leaflets with maps to help you.</li></ol>

Mrs Simpson and Mrs Small will collect these books in regularly this term to check that you are completing your Penny Sweets homework.</p>	<p><b>Amazing Arts and Crafts</b> (Choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Draw, colour, paint or make a seaside, rock pool or an island, think about the features – for example: a beach, boats on the sea, a pier, a lighthouse, cliffs, harbour, rocks</li><li>2) Make a model lighthouse – we have been reading The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch.</li></ol>
