### Reading You can read:

- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book at least 3 times a week, **we assess the children at the end of each month to see if they are ready to move up. They will not be allowed to move up if they are not reading at home.**
- Other Fiction books, short stories, poetry collections
- magazines, comics, newspapers
- Non-fiction books, information texts, recipe books



### Practise your 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

- counting in 2, 3, 5 and 10, forwards and backwards.
- 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table games on the internet.
- Listen to 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table songs.



(Use your times tables book to record any work you do on your tables)

### Learn spellings

- Look, say, cover, write, check
- Ask someone to test you
- Is there a spelling rule that helps?
- Identify the tricky part & a way to remember it

### Wonderful Writing

- 1) Write an advert encouraging people to come and visit Desborough. Remember READER QUESTIONS! (Why should they come? What will they do there? How can they get there? )

### Great Geography (choose 1)

- 1) Go for a walk around Desborough and draw a map showing where you have been.
- 2) Make a list of the human features (man-made) on your road.
- 3) Make a list of the physical features (things that were there before humans) in Desborough.
- 4) Make a list or show on a map all of the places you have been in the month of May.

### Daring Design (Choose 1)

- 1) Can you make a moving vehicle with a chassis and axles to travel around our class map.
- 2) Can you make a model of one of the buildings in Desborough to place on our class map.

**Marvellous Maths -Money focus.** We have learnt to use all the coins up to £2, and notes up to £20 but to keep that knowledge alive...

- 1) Can you make an amount with coins? How many different ways can you make that amount? How much change you would get back if you paid too much? How much of your spending money you would have left after you paid for something?
