<p><u>Reading</u> You can read:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book- Other Fiction books, short stories, poetry collections- magazines, comics, newspapers- Non-fiction books, information texts, recipe books <p><i>Make sure that an adult signs your Reading Record every time you read so that you can earn House Points.</i></p>	<p><u>Wonderful Writing</u> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Write a story where you are magically transported back to the Stone Age.2) Write a news report imagining that an important Stone Age artefact has been found in the school grounds. What was found and what will happen next?	
<p><u>Practise your times tables</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Write, cover, check- Forwards, backwards, mixed up- Ask someone to test you- Roll a dice and multiply the numbers- find songs and games online.	<p><u>Magnificent Maths</u> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Write instructions for a friend of different methods to find $\frac{3}{4}$ of 60 (pictures, number sentences)2) Find 5 items in your house and describe its properties such as shape name, number of angles, and number of faces. (pictures/diagrams and labels)	
<p><u>Learn spellings</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Look, say, cover, write, check- Ask someone to test you- Is there a spelling rule that helps?- Identify the tricky part & a way to remember it <p><i>Don't forget spelling tests are every Friday</i></p>	<p><u>Animals and Humans</u> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Design a healthy meal including all of the food groups (vitamins and minerals, proteins and carbohydrates)(pictures and labels)2) Pick your favourite animal and research the food it eats and its physical characteristics. Display what you have found in a fact file table.
