### Reading


- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book

## Bigger Treats

### Wonderful Writing (choose 1)

- 1) Write a report explaining the similarities and differences between living under the Danelaw and living in other parts of Britain at the time.
- 2) Write a description of the character of either Astrid or Bjarni from 'The Cursed Sword'. Think about their personality and how they act at different parts of the story and their motivation.

### Magnificent Maths (choose 1)

- 1) Invent your own maths game that includes addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of fractions. Think about finding common denominators and converting from mixed to improper etc.
- 2) Make some fraction, decimal, percentage equivalent dominoes.

### Spectacular Science (choose 1)

- 1) Go into your local area, identify some plants and try to categorise them using different criteria (2 different ways)
- 2) Design a booklet to explain the differences between harmful and helpful bacteria

### Creative Crafts (choose 1)

- 1) Make a model of a Viking longboat
- 2) Create a poster to explain the use of runes in Viking and Anglo Saxon times
