### Magnificent Maths (Choose 1)

- 1) Can you draw a clock with all the numbers in all the correct places and write a list of the times that you do things, such as have dinner, go to bed etc?
- 2) Can you write the number bonds to 10 but show the number sentences as subtractions too e.g.  $8+2=10$ ,  $2+8=10$ ,  $10-2=8$  and  $10-8=2$

### Super Science (Choose 1)

- 1) Can you keep a moon diary? How does the moon change over the month?
- 2) Go outside and play on a really cold day. What did you do? What did you wear? How did it feel?

### Wonderful Writing (Choose 1)

- 1) Can you find out about the different planets in our solar system and write a sentence about them?
- 2) Can you draw an astronaut and label what they might take to space with them?

### Amazing Arts and Crafts (Choose 1)

- 1) Make us a rocket out of junk.
- 2) Can you create a space picture?
- 3) Create your own imaginative space alien. Where do they come from? What's their name? What are they like?

Your child will have a Reading Record book kept in their book bag.
