Visit to Liverpool – Thursday 13th February

Dear Parent / Guardian,

As part of our topic on The Beatles and the 1960's, we have organised a trip for Year 6 to visit Liverpool on Thursday 13th February. The trip will include a visit to the Beatles Experience and Discovery Zone where the children will be immersed in the cultural legacy of The Mersey Beat, as well as a walk discovering local landmarks relating to The Beatles.

The cost of the trip will be £19.50. This covers entry into the Beatles Experience and Discovery Zone (£187.50) and coach travel (£695), minus a donation of £100 from the PALS account, £150 donation received from DCDT and £50 from the Year 6 budget to help with transport costs.

Children need to arrive at school by 7.25am ready to leave promptly at 7.30am to allow enough time for all the activities planned through the day. The coach will be leaving Liverpool at 4pm and returning to Loatlands at approximately 7.30pm (assuming no traffic delays). Children must be collected from school by an adult.

Children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. Your child will need to bring plenty of food and drink for the day; this could include a flask with something hot such as soup or pasta which they can eat at lunchtime and then sandwiches for later, or it can be 2 packed lunches. Children can also bring some spending money for the shop at the Beatles Experience.

Payment can be made online through your child's SchoolMoney account or by debit/credit card through the school office. If you are in receipt of an orange virtual voucher from school, this can also be used to make payment, please advise the school office if you would like to use your voucher. All payments should be made by Friday 7th February. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled.
