## **Primary School Applications**

A reminder that parents of children who have their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018 need to apply for their school place by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018 (5pm). Parents need to register online at [www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions) and you will then be emailed with a link which you will need to go through to make your application. You must press **submit** on completing your application and if you go back into your application again at any time up to the closing date, you must ensure you press **submit** again. Every year parents who forget to resubmit are distraught as this often costs their child a place at their preferred school. **Wednesday 20th December:** Christmas Play Day, please come and watch at 10.40-11.40am or 2.10- 3.10pm, session times for children are as normal.











