Riding Right

- Wear a Helmet and Fasten it.
- Wear Bright Clothing.
- Put Reflectors on Your Clothes, Helmet, and Bike for night riding.
- Obey the Rules of the Road.
- Look Both Ways. Most crashes happen at intersections or driveways.
- Ride on the Right Hand Side of the Road.
- Walk your bike across busy intersections.
- Lock up or protect your bike.
- Ride with Friends.

In any case, the child should always have their parents' approval first. In addition, it is also a good idea to have a fail-safe plan in place such as calling them shortly after the meeting begins so that they can bail out if they feel uncomfortable.
