We have been on a Bear Hunt this week in nursery! First, we read the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and then we went on a real Bear Hunt in the school grounds. We found lots of thick, oozy mud which made the sound 'squelch, squerch' as we walked through it! We have also been singing the song, 'The Bear Went over the Mountain', ask your child to sing it to you.



You may have noticed on our Parent Board that we are beginning to introduce a 'Sign of the week'. Makaton uses signs and symbols to help support the development of spoken language, social interactions and listening and attention skills. Please check the board each week to keep up to date with our latest sign, this week is 'Bear'.

We will continue with the children's enthusiasm for the story next week and also look at some information books about hibernation. We may even make some homes in our garden for our visiting animals to help keep them warm this winter.
