School Office

Please can we ask that only one family to be in the school office area at one time to avoid crossing bubbles. Please wait outside until the area is clear.

Hot Weather

In preparation for any hot weather - please remember to apply sun cream before school during any sunny weather. Children may wear hats and sunglasses, but please ensure they are clearly named before sending them into school. Although it should be warm sunny weather, we also need all children to have a coat available should it turn wet. Please can all children have a named water bottle in school each day. This bottle is for the children to use throughout the school day and should only contain water. This is additional to their lunch drink.



Medical Appointments during School time

If your child needs to attend a medical appointment during the school day, please let the school office know and provide a copy of the letter/appointment card via email prior to the appointment so this can be properly recorded as a medical appointment on your child's records.

Medicines/creams in school

If your child needs to have medicine or cream to be applied in school, a medical form is required to be completed before this can be used. This can be downloaded from the school website or emailed from the school office.

Year 6 Pupils joining Montsaye Academy

Children going to Montsaye Academy from September who live outside of Rothwell and are entitled or will be getting a bus to school should ensure that they apply for their bus passes through the NCC website no later than **Friday 14th May**. Applying after this date may delay in the receipt of bus passes at the start of term.





Bus transportation to school

Whether or not your child is entitled to *free* bus transportation to school, if you want your child to use the county run service, you have to fill out a form to apply for this online via the Northamptonshire County Council website:
