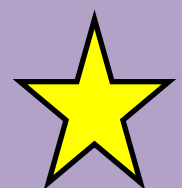
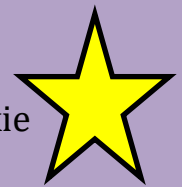

### LFD Home Testing Kits

A reminder that LFD testing is for adults only and **should not be used on primary age school children**. (The instructions given do provide information regarding testing on children but this **should not be used for primary children** and is in place to support testing for secondary pupils)

### If your child has any of the coronavirus symptoms, you must book a PCR test.

The guidance also states that, should a positive result be obtained, then the whole household will need to isolate and a confirmatory PCR test carried out. A negative result does not guarantee you do not have the virus and therefore does not lessen the need for face coverings, social distancing and other mitigating safety precautions.

### Parking

Could we remind parents that they should not:

- park within 10 metres of a junction
- be double parked

- park within the school vehicle gate entrance

Please be reminded that if there is a fire or accident near to the schools access is required for all emergency vehicles to get to the scene as quickly and as safely as possible. If you are parking in a way that the emergencies services cannot get through you are putting peoples lives at risk and action will be taken against you in the way of tickets being issued and or vehicles being removed for obstruction.

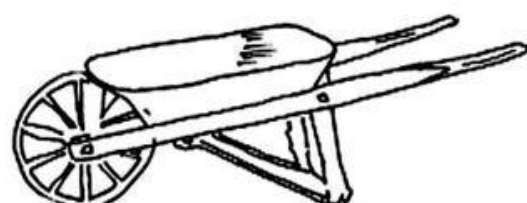
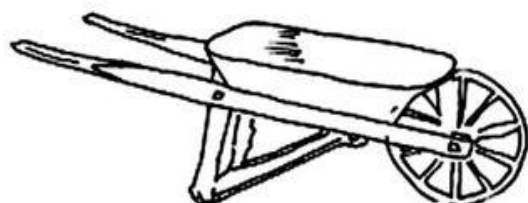
