Reading You can read:


- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book
- Other Fiction books, short stories, poetry collections
- magazines, comics, newspapers
- Non-fiction books, information texts, recipe books

Make sure that an adult signs your Reading Record every time you read so that you can change your book and move levels.



Practise your times tables

- Write, cover, check
- Forwards, backwards, mixed up
- Ask someone to test you
- Roll a dice and multiply the numbers



Learn spellings

- Look, say, cover, write, check
 - Ask someone to test you
 - Is there a spelling rule that helps?
 - Identify the tricky part & a way to remember it
- Don't forget spelling tests are every **Friday**.*

Bigger Treats

Wonderful Writing (choose 1)

- 1) Write a poem to describe a mythical Greek monster like the Minotaur or Medusa. It doesn't need to rhyme and should have lots of lovely adjectives to describe your monster e.g. menacing, mysterious Medusa.
- 2) If you were a Greek God, what would your name be and what special powers would you have? Write a character description.

Magnificent Maths (choose 1)

- 1) Create a maze and record all the directions and turns to help your hero escape from the maze.
- 2) Times tables – make a fortune teller to help you learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Super science (choose 1)

- 1) Make a game using magnets. Remember to include written instructions on how to play and who the game is for.
- 2) Draw a picture of a car and label all the forces acting on it to make it start and stop moving. Use the terms: push, pull, force and friction.

Poster Perfect (choose 1)

Design a poster for any of these topics:

- 1) Design a poster for safety when watching a firework display. Think about what the adults do too.
- 2) How can we show 'sportsmanship'? Draw and label a typical playtime showing good sportsmanship.
- 3) Design your own Advent calendar – each window will need a different picture and should open

Amazing Arts and Crafts (choose 1)

- 1) Make a 3D model of a famous Ancient Greek building like The Parthenon– use any material that you like. Add labels too!
- 2) Make a gruesome Greek set of armour, helmet or shield out of junk box materials.
