
### Reading

You can read:

### Practise your times tables

- Write, cover, check

- Ask someone to test you  
- Roll a dice and multiply the numbers

## Bigger Treats

### Wonderful Writing (choose 1)

- 1) Write a story about one page in length about your family surviving an extreme weather event, like a tsunami or a blizzard.
- 2) Write a diary entry about half a page in length imagining you are witnessing the explosion of a volcano like Mount Vesuvius.

### Magnificent Maths (choose 1)

- 1) Produce a list of rules for column adding and subtraction, explain carryover/exchange and show examples of each. (See your teacher for an example)
- 2) Create your own 'pairs' card game where the players have to match units of measure of length (mm, cm, metre and KM) or time (days, months, years, seconds, minutes, hours).

### Rocks and soil (choose 1)

- 1) Examine the soil in your garden or a nearby park or field. Record what it looks like, feels like and is made up of in a scientific manner (diagram, photograph with labels, table)
- 2) Find stones in your garden to compare. Record your findings in a table or with labelled diagrams comparing size, texture, shape, colour and weight.

### Poster Perfect (choose 1)

Design a poster for any of these topics:

- 1) to explain how and why a volcano is formed.
- 2) to help younger children to learn the number names to 10 in French
- 3) to explain how a fossil is formed – use diagrams, labels and captions.

### Amazing Arts and Crafts (choose 1)

- 1) Design and make fairy cakes with a Halloween, Bonfire Night or Christmas theme.
- 2) Design a miniature rock garden – you can make the real model in a shoe box lid.
