Dear Parents

A residential visit has been arranged to Kingswood Activity Centre in Staffordshire for Monday 30th September to Friday 4th October 2019. The visit is for the current Year 5 children, who will be in Year 6 when they go on residential.

The centre features multi-purpose activity spaces and a thrilling adventure park that includes a zip wire, abseiling and climbing. A range of evening activities is also offered including campfire, disco, movie night and mini Olympics. All the activities are led by fully-qualified instructors.

The cost of the trip is £250.

If you would like to secure a place for your child, a non-returnable deposit of £50 is needed by 1st February 2019. Virtual vouchers cannot be used to pay the deposit, however they can be used to pay the remaining balance. Payment can be made online through your child's SchoolMoney account or by credit/debit card through the school office. Further instalments of £50 will be due on 1st March, 1st April, 1st May and 1st June. These dates are set to coincide with payment dates set by Kingswood. The dates above are suggested dates; you can pay in smaller amounts and at different times throughout the month if this works better for you. However, payment in full **MUST** be received by the end of June 2019.

May I also take this opportunity to emphasise that residential trips, though beneficial, have to be rigorously managed. Consequently, response to discipline and good behaviour are pre-requisites to the trip so that staff can be certain pupils will respond in an appropriate manner at all times. The school reserves the right to exclude any pupils from the activity if their behaviour in school is such, that it could put themselves, other pupils, staff or public at risk or inconvenience.
