As soon as restrictions allow, return to our popular reading sessions and family open afternoons so that you get the chance to be in school and see your child's work and talk to their teacher.

Develop further our ways of communicating with parents about children's progress, particularly those with SEND, to ensure that they are aware of the support provided for children and how they are getting on e.g. by holding coffee mornings and drop in sessions and returning to termly phase newsletters.
