Dear Parent/Carer,

We have organised a trip for both Year 1 classes to visit Warwick Castle as part of our topic on Castles. We will be learning about the different parts of a castle, what happened in castles and the people who lived there.

The trip has been organised for **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> July** The children will be transported by coach, which will leave at 9.15am and will return to school at 3. 15pm.

The children will spend part of the day outdoors whatever the weather so will need a waterproof coat and comfortable shoes or trainers. We ask children to wear their school uniform as usual. If the weather looks to be hot, please ensure your child applies sunscreen before they leave for school and brings a sun hat or baseball cap with them. They will also need a water bottle.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch or you can pre-order a packed lunch from ABM which will be prepared before the start of school (it will not be possible to accept orders on the day as the class will be leaving school promptly at 9.15am).

We are asking for voluntary parental contributions of £19.50 per child to cover the cost of the trip to be made by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. Payment can be made online through your child's SchoolMoney account or by debit/credit card through the school office. If you are in receipt of a virtual voucher from school, this can also be used to make payment, please advise the school office if you would like to use your voucher. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions we will be unable to go ahead with the trip.

If you have any worries about the cost of the trip or would like to discuss a payment plan, please speak with the class teachers or the school office who will be happy to help.

Please note if your child is ill on the day of the trip (including COVID) we are unable to refund the cost of the trip as we do not receive a refund from the company.
