#### My Child At School (MCAS)

By now you all hopefully have full access to the new MCAS app. If you are unable to access it please let the school office know and you can be sent a reset link. You will have to have the app downloaded first.

MCAS is the new platform where school can communicate with parents and carers. We are aware there are some teething problems with push notifications in particular, but whilst this is being looked into, please keep checking the announcement section of the app.

Soon you will be able to view and pay for any up coming trips on MCAS, we will advise when this is up and running.

We will be running short drop in sessions for parents during this term to help iron out any issues.

#### Marvellous Me

Please make sure you have downloaded the Marvellous Me App. Teachers use this app to communicate with parents and carers but mostly to celebrate your child's achievements. Please make sure you have enabled notifications, so you know when your child has done something marvellous. You will also be alerted if your child has had a bump too! (more information below)

Please note, Marvellous me is for Children in Year 1 to Year 6. Reception Children do not have Marvellous Me but will continue to use Tapetry.



#### **Accidents in School**

If your child has a minor accident in school, it will be dealt with by our team of first aiders. We will now operate a 3 tier system for accident reporting.

Tier 1 – Minor cuts, bumps and grazes. Child will be treated and kept an eye on in school - Parents/Carers will not be notified.

Tier 2 – Head / Face bump or injury our first aid team believe will need to be monitored by adults after school – Marvellous Me notification - 'I've had a bump today' or a sticker for our Reception children.

Tier 3 – Serious accidents or Injuries – phone call home

Please rest assured, staff will monitor all children who have had an accident during the school day.



#### **School Lunches**
