What happens in Year 3?

Curriculum

In Year 3, we have lots of exciting topics throughout the year, such as What a Waste, The Vikings, Angry Earth and Ancient Greece. This term we are learning about Bears and will be looking at Peru in Geography, as well as the illustrations of Paddington Bear and Winnie the Pooh in Art.

Reading

Children will read with an adult everyday during class reader or phonics sessions. Their home/school books will be changed once a week as this allows the children to re-read books at home and develop fluency to become confident readers. They should be encouraged to read a wide range of texts at home. We recommend 10 minutes a night.

Once a week, children will spend time in the library and can choose a library book. For **both** classes, this is Wednesday.

Throughout the year, children may bring home a 'core reader'. These are books are enjoyable stories that we would like all children to read or share at home.

Spellings & Homework

Every Friday, your child will bring home new spellings to learn. You can also login to Spelling Shed for some fun practice games. Spellings will be tested on the following Friday.

We will also send home some times tables homework on Fridays which will be marked together in school the following Friday.

If possible, it would be fantastic if the children could go on Times Tables Rockstars weekly, or Numbots if they still would benefit practicing their mental arithmetic..
