


The children have thoroughly enjoyed their forest school experience. Year 3 will start forest school in January and Year 1 will continue forest school every other week as per the dates parents were given in October.

- 1. Click on the **Settings** cogwheel icon at the top of the page
- 2. Click View all Outlook settings at the bottom of the page
- 3. On the left hand side menu, click on Junk email
- 4. Under Blocked senders and domains, if donotreply@teachers2parents.co.uk is listed, press the Bin icon after it to delete it.
- 5. Under **Safe senders and domains** click **+ Add**, type
- in <u>donotreply@teachers2parents.co.uk</u> and enter to save. (You could also add this email to the Safe mailing lists further down)

6. Click **Save** in the top right corner.
