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#### **Oxford Owl Online Reading**

We have recently subscribed to www.oxfordowl.co.uk. This website provides a range of eBooks that your child will now be able to access from home. Each class has their own login which your child can use to access books from our reading scheme on any mobile, tablet, laptop or desktop computer and is intended to supplement their reading at home. These books will not take the place of the books we send home with your child but will give them a greater variety of choice and opportunities to choose new books. An information sheet with instructions on how to get logged in and start choosing books and also details your child's class login have been emailed home this week.
