
Celebration Assembly

BBC Bitesize

As a third national lockdown is under way, the BBC is bringing hundreds of educational resources together to help with home-schooling.

They have tailored their offer to support teachers' provision of remote learning. Collections of educational resources on the BBC Bitesize and BBC Teach websites are available to support online learning at home for pupils in Years 1 to 9, and those studying for GCSEs and Nationals.

In addition, from Monday 11 January lessons and programmes have been broadcast on TV - on BBC Two and CBBC - as well as on iPlayer, providing support for children unable to access online resources.

How can I access this content?

Online - Bitesize - Learning at Home offers a suite of engaging learning resources for children aged 5 to fifteen. These online lessons are full of videos, quizzes and practice activities to help students keep on track when learning at home. You can use the lessons to introduce ideas for the first time, or as refreshers.

TV - Programming for primary pupils is on CBBC between 09:00 and 12:00 each weekday. Programmes for secondary school pupils are on BBC Two, between 13:00 and 15:00.

iPlayer - All programmes are available to catch-up, on-demand on iPlayer
