Changes to Year 5 PE sessions

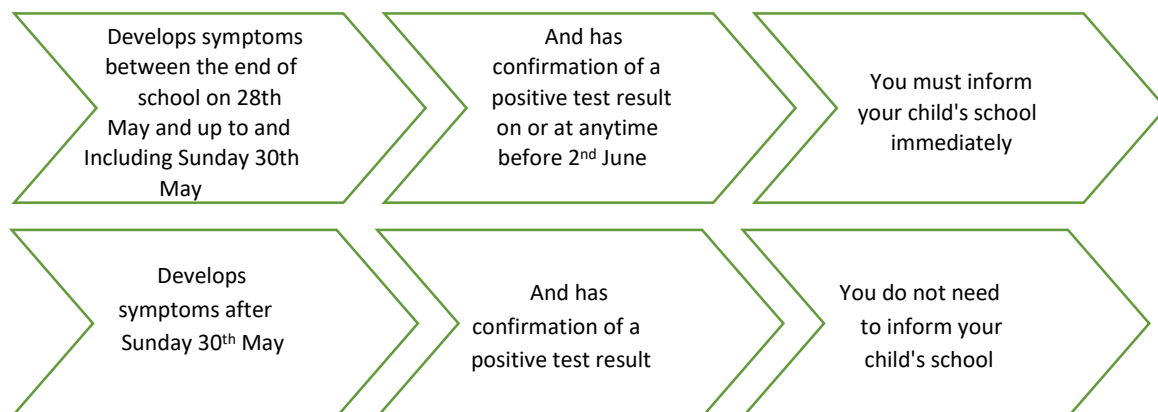
Please be advised there are changes to Year 5 PE days starting on Monday 7th June
