On Thursday 15th October we have a film crew joining us in school! The crew are going to make a short video (2 – 3 minutes long) that we will be able to share with prospective new parents this year to give them a flavour of what it is like to be a pupil at Loatlands Primary School.

As many of you will have experienced yourselves, we usually hold an open evening for prospective new parents and also invite them to visit the school during the day so that they can see us in action. Unfortunately, due to current circumstances, it is not possible to do this in a safe way this year. We have taken this opportunity to have a video created all about us. This is an approach that many schools across the country are taking.

Over the course of the day, the film crew will spend time in and around the school taking video clips of all of the wonderful things that children get up to during their time with us including Forest Schools, PE lessons in the hall and studio and Science lessons in the Discovery Room as well as some of our lessons in the classroom as well.

As this is something new and not covered on our usual permission forms, we are writing to inform you that this filming is taking place and to ask you to let us know if you would rather that your child was not filmed during this process. The video produced will be available on the school website and will be shared with prospective new parents. We fully understand that there are a wide variety of reasons that mean you do not want your child to be filmed and just ask that you let us know via email at parents@loatlandsprimary.net no later than Wednesday 14th October 2020 so that we can make the appropriate arrangements to ensure that your child is not captured on camera (please note that this might mean that we ask your child to come out of the classroom for a few minutes to be looked after by another adult elsewhere while filming takes place).

We hope that this exciting opportunity will allow some of our budding young actors to really shine and that as many of you as possible will support us in this exciting new chapter.
