Visit to Leicester Botanic Gardens – Thursday 9th June 2022

As part of our topic on ‘Rainforests’ we have organised an educational visit to Leicester Botanic Gardens on Thursday 9th June for Year 4. The children will participate in lots of fun activities connected to Rainforests, including finding out about plants and trees that grow in the Botanic Garden’s Rainforest House.

The children will be transported by coach, which will leave at 9.00am and will return to school by approximately 3.40pm.

The children will spend part of the day outdoors whatever the weather so will need a waterproof coat and comfortable shoes or trainers. We ask children to wear their school uniform as usual. If the weather looks to be hot, please ensure your child applies sunscreen before they leave for school and brings a sun hat or baseball cap with them. They will also need a water bottle.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch or you can pre-order a paid packed lunch from ABM which will be prepared before the start of school (it will not be possible to accept orders on the day as the class will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am).

We are asking for voluntary parental contributions of £13.00 per child to cover the cost of the trip. Payment can be made online through your child’s SchoolMoney account or by debit/credit card through the school office. If you are in receipt of an virtual voucher from school, this can also be used to make payment, please advise the school office if you would like to use your voucher.

Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions we will be unable to go ahead with the trip. Please can all contributions be made by Wednesday 25th May 2022.

Please note if your child is ill on the day of the trip (including COVID) we are unable to refund the cost of the trip as we do not receive a refund from the company.
