Monday 11th July	Transition Day
Tuesday 12th July	A Forest School Trip to East Carlton Country Park – the children will have the opportunity to put all of their Forest School learning to good use and will even cook their own lunch. We would be hugely grateful if parents could transport their children to and from the park as this will keep costs down by not needing to hire a coach – children should arrive at the park at 9:15am and can be collected at 3:00pm. Children will need to be dressed in their Forest School kit and appropriately dressed for the weather.
Wednesday 13th July	A trip to the cinema to see a newly released movie (details will be sent out nearer the time) in their own private screening! Children will need to be in their school uniform and can bring a snack and drink with them to enjoy while they watch the film.
Thursday 14th July	A trip out to Twin lakes for the day! Children can wear their own clothes and will need to be dressed appropriately for the weather.
